### XXVII Sunday in Ordinary Time - Mark 10,2-12,16

Traditionally, the family has been established under the protection of religious or civil marriage. From the Catholic religious point of view this beautiful institution is being trampled upon by the practice of divorce. Statistics are alarming, more divorces than religious marriages. Catholics who once resisted the practice of divorce now easily divorce or try to annul their marriage on the grounds that they no longer understand each other, that they are incompatible, that they are hurting each other, or that they don't love each other anymore.

Whatever the causes, divorce is tragic to many couples. They can leave traumas in the couple, pain in the children, resentments, confusion, hatreds, revenge and even the suppression of the life of one of the couples.

If we look in the Bible, Jesus never approved of divorce. Could we imagine Jesus speaking on a talk show on television today about divorce? No doubt He would refer to the book of Genesis 2:18-24 or Matthew 19:3-6: "That is why the man will leave his father and his mother and join his wife and they will be one flesh. For what God has united, let man not separate." Jesus emphasizes the permanence of marriage and the indissolubility of the bond; therefore, there is no law or judge that can dissolve the marriage bond. Making the clarification that when the ecclesiastical court decrees an "annulment" it means that there was no valid marriage bond.

Couples who plan to be married in the Catholic Church must make a thorough examination of the intrinsic responsibilities and demands of the sacrament of marriage which will help them in their own holiness of life and in the healthy and honest procreation of children. Therefore the spouses will be committed for a lifetime: In health when both are healthy. In disease when the weight of years or diseases deteriorates health; in riches, in poverty, joys, and sorrows. It is a whole plan of life having God as the center of that gift in prayer, Christian life and the reception of the Eucharist.

### Statement of the Archdiocese of Newark Regarding Vaccination Exemption

The Archdiocese of Newark does not provide a religious exemption for the COVID-19 vaccine. Pope Francis has urged people to get vaccinated, calling it "an act of love" and a "profound way of promoting the common good and caring for each other, especially the most vulnerable." Similarly, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, and numerous other Catholic dioceses have issued statements supporting the morality of receiving the vaccine. As such, the Archdiocese of Newark has advised its clergy not to support a religious exemption for the people entrusted in their pastoral care. We encourage all within our Catholic community to observe all applicable health and safety mandates and to remain mindful of the welfare of others.

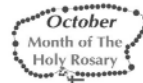

### Domingo XXVII del Tiempo Ordinario - Marcos 10, 2-12,16

Tradicionalmente la familia se ha establecido bajo el amparo del matrimonio religioso o civil. Desde el punto de vista católico religioso esta bella institución esta siendo pisoteada con la practica del divorcio. Las estadísticas son alarmantes, más proceso de divorcios que número de matrimonios religiosamente. Los católicos que antes resistían a la practica del divorcio hoy fácilmente se divorcian o tratan de anular su matrimonio alegando que ya no se entienden, que son incompatibles, que se están haciendo más daño mutuamente o que se les acabo el amor.

Sean cual fueran las causales el divorcio es trágico en muchas parejas. Pueden dejar traumas en la pareja, dolor en los hijos, resentimientos, confusión, odios, venganzas y hasta la supresión de la vida de alguna de las parejas.

Si analizamos bíblicamente Jesús nunca aprobó el divorcio. ¿Podríamos imaginar hoy a Jesús hablando en un talk show en la televisión acerca del divorcio? Sin lugar a dudas Él haría referencia al libro del Genesis 2,18-24 o Mateo 19,3-6: "Por eso dejara el hombre a su padre y a su madre y se unira a su mujer y seran los dos una sola carne. Pues lo que Dios ha unido que no lo separe el hombre." Jesús hace énfasis en la permanencia del matrimonio y de la indisolubilidad del vinculo; por ende, no hay ley ni juez que pueda disolver el vincula matrimonial. Haciendo la aclaración que cuando el tribunal eclesiástico decreta una "anulación" significa que no hubo vinculo matrimonial valido.

Las parejas que piensan casarse por la Iglesia Católica tiene que hacerse un examen concienzudo de las responsabilidades y exigencias intrínsecas del sacramento del matrimonio el cual les ayudara a la propia santidad de vida y a la procreación sana y honesta de los hijos. Por lo tanto los contrayentes se van a comprometer por toda la vida: En la salud cuando ambos estan saludables. En la enfermedad, cuando el peso de los años o las enfermedades diezman la salud; en las riquezas, en la pobreza, alegrías, tristezas. Es todo un plan de vida teniendo a Dios como el centro de esa entrega en la oración, vida cristiana y recepción de la Eucaristía.

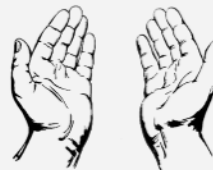

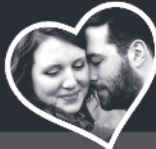
