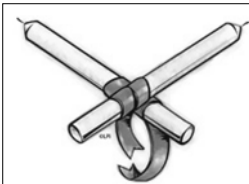

Catholic Education in the United States

National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. It starts on Sunday, January 29 and ends on Friday, February 3. The theme for the National Catholic Schools Week 2023 is "Catholic Schools: Faith, Excellence, Service." Catholic schools have a specific purpose to form students to be good citizens of the world, love God and neighbor and enrich society with the leaven of the gospel and by example of faith.

As communities of faith, Catholic schools instill in students their destiny to become saints. Academic excellence is the hallmark of Catholic education intentionally directed to the growth of the whole person - mind, body and spirit. Finally, service is fundamental to Catholic education and the core of Catholic discipleship. Service is intended to help form people who are not only witnesses to Catholic social teaching, but also active participants through social learning.

Catholic education is an expression of the mission entrusted by Jesus to the Church. Through education, the Church seeks to prepare children and their families to proclaim the Good News, and to translate this proclamation into action. Our Catholic schools afford an opportunity to realize the threefold purpose of Christian education among young people - message, community, and service.

OUR FASCINATING FAITH

Candlemas (February 2)

Thanks to Pope Sergius I (687-701), on February 2 we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord. On this day we also commemorate the Purification of Mary, who complied with the Jewish law (Leviticus 12:1). The law indicated that a mother should be purified forty days after giving birth to a boy child. Since the eleventh century the Purification of Mary and the Presentation of the Lord have been celebrated with the blessing of all the candles and candlesticks that are going to be used during the year. This is done with the hope that there will never be a lack of light, either material or spiritual, in the houses of the faithful. The root of the word candlemas is the Latin verb *candere* ("to shine") and from which also come the words candelabra and candlestick. This feast of candles recalls that Christians can, like Simon and the prophetess Anna in the temple, say that they also have seen salvation: Jesus the true Light who shines in the arms of Mary (Luke 2:25-38).

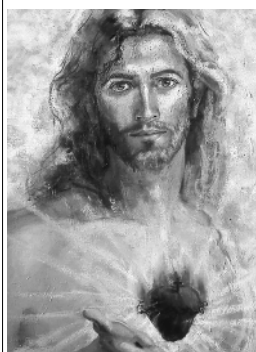

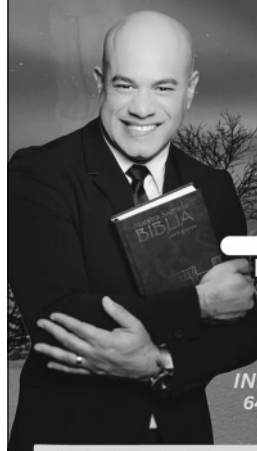

NUESTRA FASCINANTE FE

La Candelaria

Gracias al Papa Sergio I (687–701), el día 2 de febrero se celebra la Presentación de Jesús en el Templo. En este día se conmemora también la Purificación de María que cumplía con la Ley Judía (Levítico 12:1–2). Dicha ley indicaba que una madre debía ser purificada cuarenta días después de que diera a luz a un varoncito. Desde el undécimo siglo, la celebración de la Purificación de María y la Presentación del Niño Jesús en el templo se conmemoran con la bendición de todas las velas y veladoras que se van a usar durante el año. Esto se hace con la esperanza de que nunca falte la luz, tanto material como espiritual en las casas de los fieles. La palabra candelaria viene del verbo latín *candere* (brillar), de allí la palabra candela, o sea, veladora. Esta fiesta de candelas recuerda que los cristianos como Simeón y la profetiza Ana en el Templo pueden decir que ellos también han visto la salvación; Jesús la verdadera luz que brilla en brazos de María (Lucas 2:25–38).
