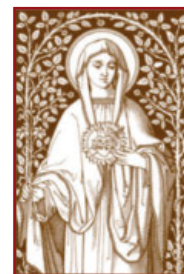

Third Sunday of Lent



The woman in today's Gospel comes to the well to draw water, something she has probably done every day of her life since she herself remembers. But this day she meets the Messiah and her whole life changes.

At first the woman felt stunned by this stranger. Why did this Jew speak to her, a Samaritan and alone? And why did he come to Jacob's well without a bucket or jar? She was surprised that he somehow knew her whole marital history and that she was not married to the man she lived with now. In the end, she came to believe in him. She first recognized him as a prophet and then realized that he was none other than the Messiah. In the course of an extraordinary conversation she came to believe and her newly discovered faith led her to go and give witness to her neighbors about the Christ.

Today we celebrate the first of the three Sundays of Scrutiny. It is an occasion to delve deeply and honestly into our heart to discover and remedy our sins, and to bring out and reinforce everything that is good. When Jesus found the woman by the well he looked into her heart and saw her story, thus provoking in the depths of her heart a flame of faith in a Messiah who told her everything she had done. She immediately began to be a missionary, testifying to everything he had told her and proclaiming that he was the Messiah. As these Scrutinies direct our catechumens to the waters of baptism in Christ, let us seize the opportunity they give us to continue the mission of the baptized and to bear witness that we know the works of Christ. The waters of Baptism erase our sins and also quench our spiritual thirst.

The water that God provided the chosen people in the desert did the same. God could have punished them for belittling Moses and calling God to account. On the contrary, God provided them with water and thus offered them sustenance and forgiveness. Jesus could have embarrassed the woman because of her many marriages, but on the contrary, he offered her living water, which gave her eternal life. Similarly, we do not deserve the living water of eternal life that we receive at Baptism, but Jesus offers it to us for his love and mercy when we are still sinners, as St. Paul says.

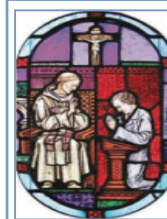
April 16, 2023 - 3:00 p.m. - 50 years (All counties)

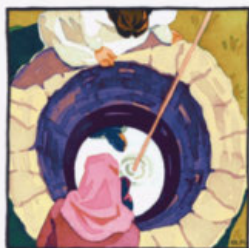

TERCER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA



La mujer en el Evangelio de hoy viene al pozo para sacar agua, algo que probablemente ha hecho todos los días de su vida desde que ella misma recuerde. Pero este día se encuentra con el Mesías y toda su vida cambia.

Al principio la mujer se sentía aturdida por este desconocido. ¿Por qué este judío le hablaba a ella, una samaritana y a solas? Y, ¿por qué vino él al pozo de Jacob sin cubo ni jarro? Ella se sorprendió de que él de alguna manera supiera toda la historia marital de ella y de que no estuviera casada con el hombre con quien vivía en la actualidad. Al final, ella llegó a creerle. Primero lo reconoció como un profeta y después se dio cuenta de que era nada menos que el Mesías. En el transcurso de una conversación extraordinaria ella llegó a creer y su fe recién descubierta la llevó a ponerse en marcha y dar testimonio a sus vecinos acerca del Cristo.

Hoy celebramos el primero de los tres domingos de escrutinios. Es una ocasión para ahondar profunda y honestamente en nuestro corazón e ir descubriendo y poniendo remedio a nuestros pecados, y sacar a flote todo lo que hay ahí de bueno para reforzarlo. Cuando Jesús encontró a la mujer junto al pozo miró en el corazón de ella y vio su historia, y también provocó en lo más profundo del corazón de ella una llama de fe en un Mesías que le dijo todo lo que ella había hecho. Inmediatamente ella comenzó a ser misionera, dando testimonio de todo lo que él le había dicho y proclamando que él era el Mesías. A medida que estos escrutinios dirigen a nuestros catecúmenos hacia las aguas del bautismo en Cristo, aprovechemos la oportunidad que nos brindan para continuar la misión de los bautizados y de dar testimonio de que conocemos las obras de Cristo.

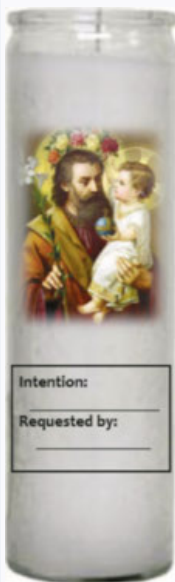
Las aguas del Bautismo borran nuestros pecados y además sacian nuestra sed espiritual. El agua que Dios proporcionó al pueblo escogido en el desierto hizo lo mismo. Dios hubiese podido castigarlo por menospreciar a Moisés y pedirle cuentas a Dios. Por el contrario, Dios les proporcionó agua y así les ofreció el sustento y el perdón. Jesús pudo haber avergonzado a la mujer por sus tantos matrimonios, pero por el contrario, le ofreció el agua viva, que le daba la vida eterna. De manera similar, nosotros no nos merecemos el agua viva de la vida eterna que recibimos en el Bautismo, pero Jesús nos la ofrece por su amor y misericordia cuando aún somos pecadores, como dice san Pablo.
