SUNDAY XVIII :

LA TRANSFIGURACIÓN DEL SEÑOR

Daniel 7,9-10.13-14, 2 Pedro 1,16-19, Mateo 17,1-9

Claro está que esto exige entrega generosa al amor de Cristo en nuestra vida lo cual nos lleve a llenarnos de un amor profundo y comprometido con Dios como lo hizo Pedro quien en aquel momento de gracia sobrenatural se olvidó de si mismo y de sus realidades terrenas en preparación de la futura responsabilidad de cargar y sostener la fe de los apóstoles continuadores de la misión de edificar la Iglesia.

Esta celebración de la transfiguración debe ser una invitación a un compromiso de santidad de vida como lo han hecho miles de santos quienes han encontrado en el seguimiento de Jesús en una vida contemplativa y activa en el servicio y construcción del Reino de Dios desde el tiempo de Jesús hasta nuestros días.

Que el Señor Jesús nos regale la gracia del Tabor, que transforme nuestras vidas como transformó a Pablo de Tarso, a San Agustín, a San Francisco de Asís y tantos otros fieles seguidores de la construcción del Reino de Dios.

The Transfiguration of the Lord

Daniel 7,9-10.13-14, 2 Peter 1,16-19, Matthew 17,1-9



During his pastoral time on earth, Jesus, after having chosen the twelve apostles and having shown them with his teachings and miracles, before his passion he went up the mountain with Peter, James and John and was transfigured before their eyes. His face turned bright like the sun and his clothes turned white like snow. Suddenly Moses and Elijah appeared before them conversing with Jesus.

Peter, surprised by the phenomenon, said to Jesus: "Master, how good it is to be here. If you want we can do 3 things: one for You, one for Moses and one for Elijah." But as Peter spoke, a luminous cloud covered them, and the voice of the Father was heard, saying: "This is my beloved Son, in whom I have placed my pleasures. Listen to him" They fell face to the ground full of terror. Jesus came to them and said, "Get up and fear not." The apostles arose and saw no one but Jesus.

Jesus was gradually preparing the apostles for his future mission in his future Church. Coming down from the mountain he asked them not to say anything about this episode, but this transfiguration of Jesus before these three future pillars of the Church was a special grace; foretaste of the glory of the Resurrection and a demonstration by the Eternal Father of the divinity of his Son Jesus.

This feast of the Transfiguration is an invitation for us Christians to transform our lives through a deeply spiritual intimacy with Jesus that leads us to a sanctity of cleansed and committed life with the most vulnerable and the poor.

Of course, this requires generous dedication to the love of Christ in our lives, which leads us to be filled with a deep and committed love for God as Peter did, who in that moment of supernatural grace forgot about himself and his earthly realities in preparation of the future responsibility to carry on and sustain the faith of the apostles who continued the mission of building up the Church.

This celebration of the transfiguration should be an invitation to a commitment to holiness of life as thousands of saints have, who found in following Jesus a contemplative and active life in the service and construction of the Kingdom of God from the time of Jesus to the present day.

May the Lord Jesus give us the grace of Tabor. May he transform our lives as he transformed Paul of Tarsus, St. Augustine, St. Francis of Assisi and so many other faithful followers of building the Kingdom of God.
