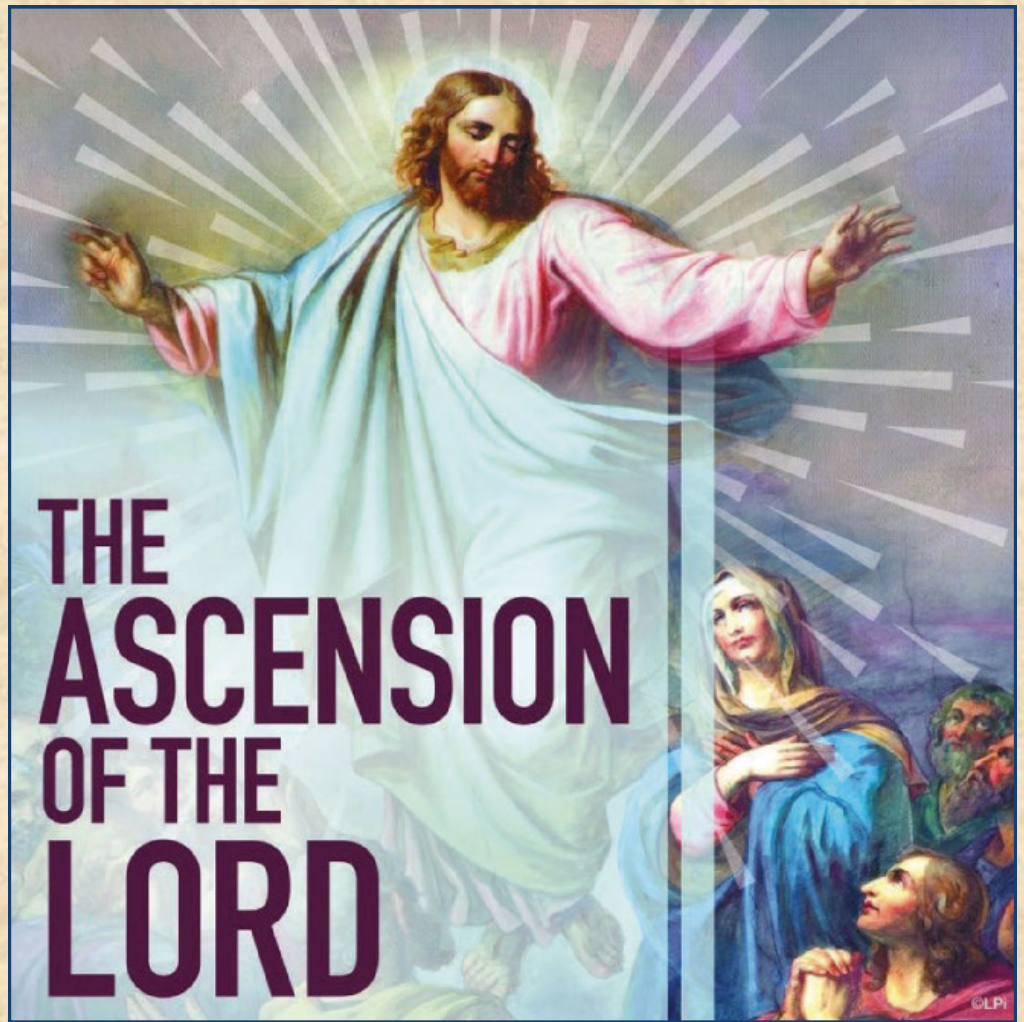

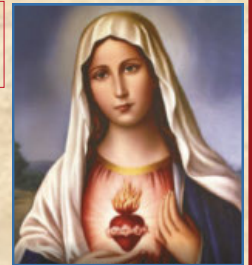

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA ASCENSION DEL SEÑOR

Queridos Hermanos en el Señor, la Vida y el Amor, saludos y bendiciones en este caminar fraterno en el mes hermoso de la Virgen viviendo este tiempo de Pascua.

Que alegría poder compartir una vez más una pequeña reflexión para nuestro crecimiento espiritual y personal.

Este es un fin de semana de gran celebración. En medio del fresco primaveral los aires veraniegos son más cálidos y acogedores; mientras celebramos este Segundo domingo de mayo El Día de Las Madres: nuestro amor y nuestro corazón agradecido infinitamente con nuestras madres vivas y nuestra oración por nuestras madres difuntas.

Junto a lo anterior el Santo Padre nos insta a orar *"para que las religiosas, los religiosos y los seminaristas crezcan en su camino vocacional a través de una formación humana, pastoral, espiritual y comunitaria, que les lleve a ser testigos creíbles del Evangelio"*.

Este domingo es también el Domingo de la Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor. Una celebración en la que los apóstoles viven una alegría y sinsabor a la vez. Al respecto de esta Solemnidad, Antonio Pariente, nos dice: *"Con la celebración de la Ascensión estamos a punto de terminar el tiempo pascual. Contemplamos a Jesús en su partida y encomendando a los suyos la misión de ir al mundo entero y proclamad el evangelio. Jesús se va, aparentemente los deja solos, ha llegado la hora de los apóstoles, de aquellos que durante tres años estuvieron con Él, y se convencieron que vivir como Él vivió, y anunciarlo a los demás merecía la pena. Nadie los obligó, cada uno pudo volverse a su casa tranquilamente, pero no, el recuerdo de Jesús, su vida, su ejemplo los había marcado de tal modo, que se decidieron a continuar su misión. ¿Qué hacéis ahí plantados mirando al cielo?, aquellos galileos estaban tan marcados por las palabras de Jesús y por el resplandor de su gloria que no se podían ni mover. Pero, volverán a Jerusalén y desde allí se dispersarán hasta los confines del mundo, para proclamar las maravillas de Dios, maravillas que en aquellos momentos no podía ni sospechar y de la que ellos serán los primeros testigos. Sólo les queda una cosa, recibir el Espíritu, recibir el Espíritu para que nazca la Iglesia, espíritu que los lanzará a ser testigos de aquello que habían conocido, visto y sentido. Lo celebraremos el próximo domingo, día de Pentecostés"*.

Vamos pues mis queridos hermanos a reflexionar este Domingo y esta semana unidos en oración y corresponsabilidad sin desanimarnos y recordar las promesas del Señor Jesucristo a sus discípulos.

Que este bello y fresco tiempo sea una oportunidad para "abrasar" nuestros corazones el fuego de su Espíritu y nos inspire a caminar con nuestra Iglesia, siempre en misión, con un Corazón Agradecido, alegre y compasivo.

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Dear Brothers in the Lord, Life and Love, greetings and Blessings in this fraternal walk during this beautiful month of the Virgin living this Easter season.

What a joy to be able to share once again a small reflection for our spiritual and personal growth. This is a weekend of great celebration. In the midst of the cool spring, the summer air is warmer and more welcoming as we celebrate this second Sunday of May, Mother's Day: our love and our infinitely grateful heart to our living mothers and our prayers for our deceased mothers.

In addition to the above, the Holy Father urges us to pray *"that men and women religious and seminarians may grow in their vocational journey through a more human, pastoral, spiritual and community formation that leads them to be credible witnesses of the Gospel"*.

This Sunday is also the Sunday of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. A celebration in which the apostles experienced joy and sorrow at the same time. Regarding this Solemnity, Antonio Pariente tells us: *"With the celebration of the Ascension we are about to end the Easter season. We contemplate Jesus on his departure and entrusting his own with the mission of going into the whole world and proclaiming the gospel. Jesus is leaving, seemingly leaving them alone, the time has come for the apostles, for those who for three years were with Him, and they were convinced that living as He lived, and proclaiming Him to others was worth it. No one forced them, each one could return to his house calmly, but no, the memory of Jesus, his life, his example had marked them in such a way that they decided to continue his mission. What are you doing there looking up at heaven? Those Galileans were so marked by the words of Jesus and by the radiance of his glory that they could not move. But they will return to Jerusalem and from there they will disperse to the ends of the world, to proclaim the wonders of God, wonders that at that time they could not even suspect and of which they will be the first witnesses. There is only one thing left for them, to receive the Spirit; receive the Spirit so that the Church may be born, a spirit that will launch them to be witnesses of what they had known, seen and felt. We will celebrate it next Sunday, the day of Pentecost."*

Let us, then, my dear brothers and sisters, reflect this Sunday and this week, united in prayer and co-responsibility, without being discouraged, and remembering the promises of the Lord Jesus Christ to his disciples.

May this beautiful and fresh time be an opportunity to "burn" our hearts with the fire of His Spirit and inspire us to walk with our Church, always on a mission, with a grateful, joyful and compassionate Heart.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Ascension of the Lord

Question:

Couldn't Jesus have done more good if he stayed on earth, rather than ascended into heaven?

Answer:

This is an interesting question! During his earthly life, Jesus gave sight to the blind, healed paralytics, drove out demons, and fed thousands with only a few loaves of bread. Imagine what he could have done if he'd never ascended into heaven! Imagine what our world could be! It's an interesting thought to consider, especially as the world faces challenges that only seem to deepen and expand. Yet at the Last Supper, Jesus says, "It is better for you if I go." Why? His response must have seemed strange to the Apostles at the time. In his place, Jesus says, he will send the Paraclete, the Comforter, the Advocate. He promises to send the Holy Spirit.

Jesus' departure allows the Apostles to become the leaders he has formed them to be. Jesus is no longer situated in only one geographical location, and his Church will never be a political kingdom. Soon after the Ascension, we celebrate Pentecost — the descent of the Holy Spirit and the radical empowerment of the followers of Jesus. We share in that empowerment and in that mission. Jesus is present in the sacraments, and he is present in us. Through our faith, hope, and love, we are called to be the good he does here on earth!

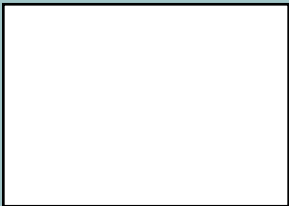
